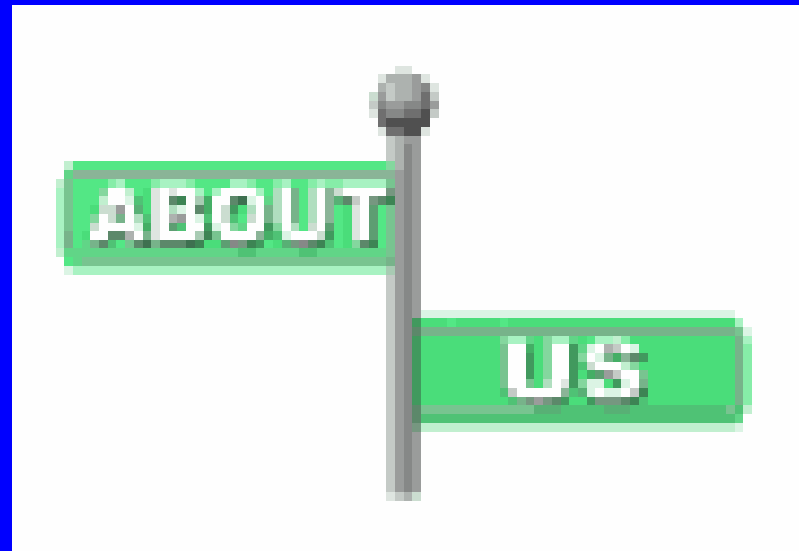

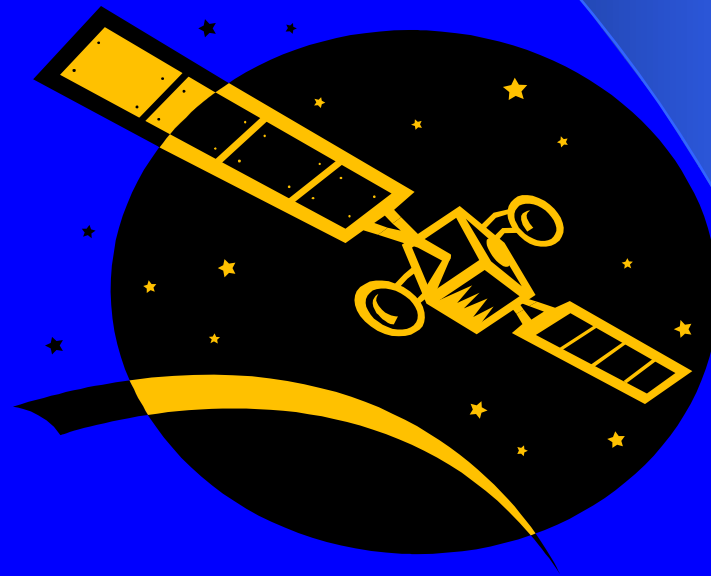
Communication

- ✓ **Help others be successful**

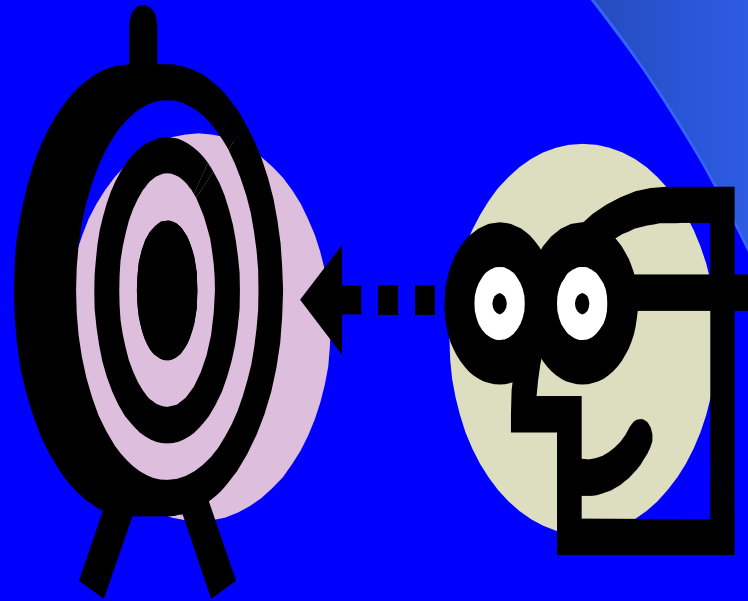
Meetings

- It is absolutely critical for everyone to know and understand why they are attending a meeting and what the outcome is intended to be.



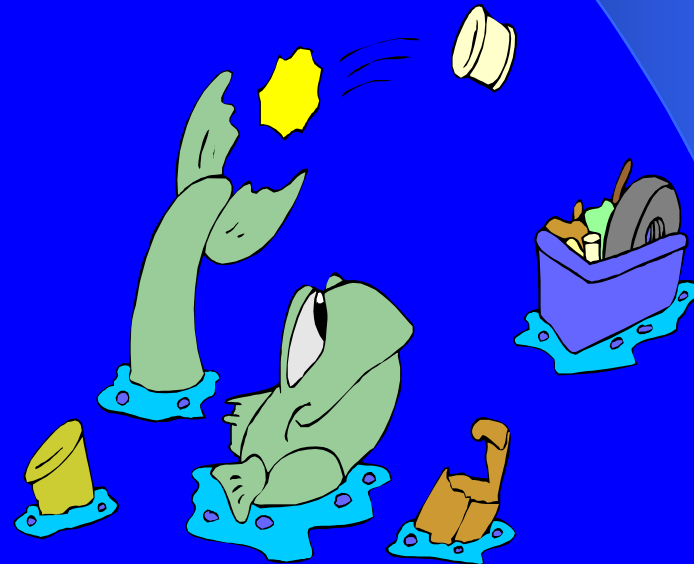
Agenda Guidelines

- Collect all the necessary data and materials.



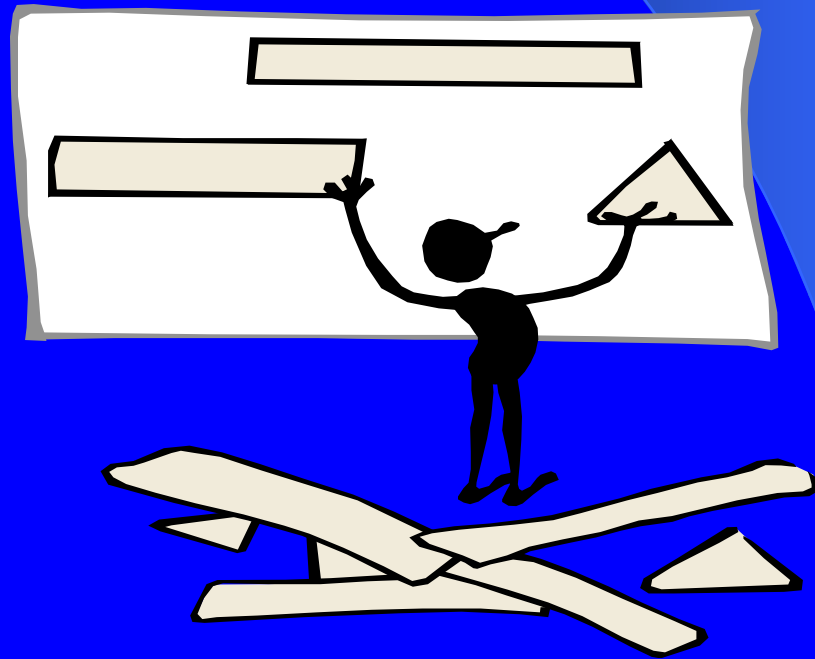
Agenda Guidelines

- All attendees should come to the meeting with an open mind and respectful attitude towards all other participants.



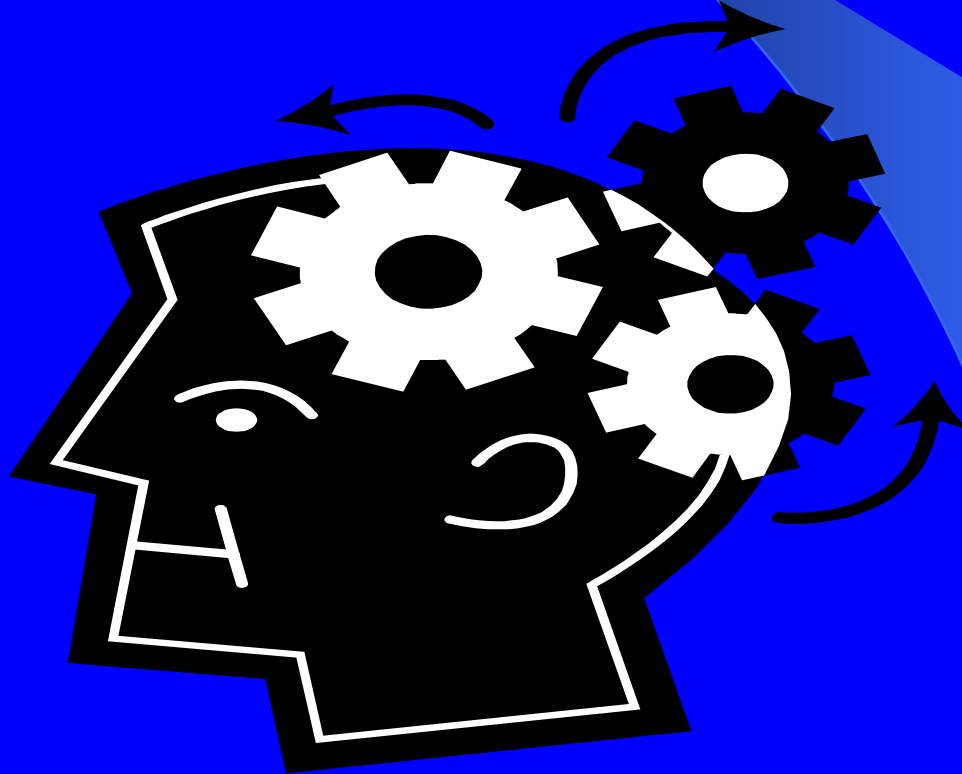

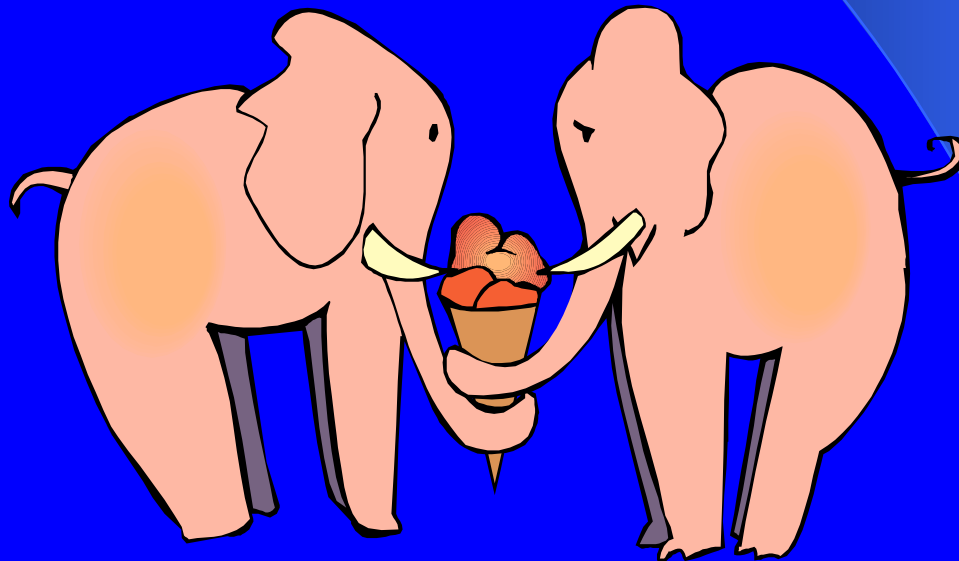
Empowerment
